Register for storytelling workshop

Humans tell stories to remember, understand and connect with each other.

Join the founders of Portland Story Theater for a lively, interactive two-hour workshop on the contemporary art of personal storytelling Saturday, Oct. 22, from 2 to 4 p.m. at the Siuslaw Public Library.

Participants will learn how to identify their stories and what it takes to share them with an audience. The workshop will explore the necessity of vulnerability in storytelling, as well as techniques for bringing your stories to life.

Portland Story Theater will perform excerpts from its stories while engaging participants to begin exploring stories of their own.

Portland Story Theater was founded in 2004 by Lawrence Howard and Lynne Duddy. Their mission is "to build community, promote understanding and fostering radical empathy by giving voice to the real, true stories of everyday people."

This workshop will be limited to 25 participants, so pre-registration is required.

The workshop will be followed later in the day with a storytelling show performed by five members of the Portland Story Theater, beginning at 7 p.m.
