The Florence Urban Renewal Agency and the City of Florence are working with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) on ReVision Florence to provide streetscaping to the Highway 101 corridor.

In 2018, ODOT will be repaving the segment of Highway 101 from the Siuslaw River Bridge to the Highway

126 intersection, and the Florence Urban Renewal Agency has been working on a streetscape design to coordinate with that project.

As the agencies work through the ReVision Florence design process, they are seeking public input on the conceptual design.

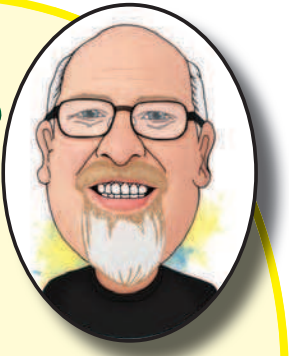
