Integral part of life, work, play

The Siuslaw Region Vision builds on the Florence Event Center's 20 successful years of serving this region and looks to the future in 2025 — where the FEC is still playing an integral part in making this an area where people want to live, work and play.

In April of 2014, a Ford Institute Alumni Celebration was held in Florence, reuniting nonprofit and governmental leaders, volunteers and engaged community members from throughout western Lane County. From the gathering, a strong consensus emerged: it was time for a shared vision to bring together this rural community on the verge of transformation.

Through a region-wide survey, focus groups, community forums and ongoing meetings — many held at the FEC — over 1,200 community members have had a voice in creating a vision of the Siuslaw region in 2025.

The vision focuses on implementing a variety of identified projects, such as promoting and supporting public art, establishing a regional parks and recreation district, and supporting local workforce development.

Although only just begun, the vision action teams have made great strides toward increasing communication across different sectors of the community to ensure that everyone is working toward a common goal.

Myriad events held at the events center are at the core of the Siuslaw

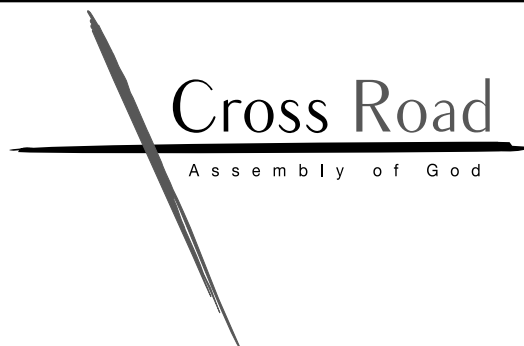


Vision to create an environment for "Working People, Happy People, Connected People, Active People, Educated People and Creative People."

Economic development events held at the FEC include Regional Accelerator and Innovation Network (RAIN) meet-ups; educational events include Robert's Rules of Order and Nonprofit Board Training; health events such as the Healthcare Town Hall and Aging in Place Forum; transportation events like ReVision Florence and the Rhododendron Drive Shoulder Extension Open House; environmental events such as the Florence Green Fair; and cultural events like the Florence Festival of Books and Dancing with Sea Lions.

The Florence Events Center provides a first class venue for all of these activities and many more. We wish the FEC another 20 years of amazing success!
