## Are you registered to vote? Check your status online

The deadline to register as a voter in the November election is Tuesday, Oct. 18.

Lane County voters can register or confirm their registration is current by visiting [www.oregonvotes.org](http://www.oregonvotes.org).

The website, maintained by the Oregon Secretary of State's Office, makes registering and updating voter registrations simple.

"The website is a great tool for voters who want to confirm their registration status before the deadline," said County Clerk Cheryl Betschart. "It is easy, fast and provides a nearly immediate update to our Lane

County voter records."

To check your voter registration status at [oregonvotes.org](http://oregonvotes.org): Select the "Voter Registration" option and click on "Check or Update Your Registration."

Voters can search for their registration information by name and birthdate. The results will indicate whether a voter's status is active and list the address to which the ballot will be mailed.

If any of this information is incorrect, select "Update Registration" to provide correct information by Oct. 18.

To register to vote in Oregon at [oregonvotes.org](http://oregonvotes.org): The online

registration option is available only to those with a valid Oregon driver's license, DMV-issued identification card or learner's permit.

People who are not registered to vote in any Oregon county may register online at [www.oregonvotes.org](http://www.oregonvotes.org) no later than 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, Oct. 18.

Other registration options:  
• Submit a voter registration form to the Elections Office by 4 p.m., Tuesday, Oct. 18.

• Mail a voter registration card to the Elections Office with a postmark no later than Tuesday, Oct. 18.

New voters who will turn 18 on or before the Nov. 8, Election Day, can register by the Oct. 18 deadline and receive a ballot, even if they are still 17 on the deadline date.

## Dunes City seeks planning commissioner

Dunes City is accepting applications for a planning commissioner. This is a volunteer position with a term ending date of Jan. 11, 2016.

The Planning Commission usually meets the fourth Thursday of the month at 5 p.m. at Dunes City Hall, and in special sessions

as necessary.

The Dunes City Planning Commission consists of five voting members, each of whom is appointed by the City Council for a three-year term.

## Western Lane Ambulance pursues levy

Western Lane Ambulance District is seeking renewal of a five-year local option levy to maintain services for the district. Voters first approved the five-year levy in 2012 to fund the district's operations costs. That levy is set to expire at the end of 2017.

The measure before voters this November asks "Shall the district renew existing 45 cents per \$1,000 assessed value for five years beginning 2017-2018 for emergency medical operations?"

Interim District Manager, Brian Burright said, "This levy renewal will allow us to continue to provide the same level of quality emergency medical services."

The levy renewal will not increase taxes or fees.

## Community survey available now on ReVision Florence

Florence Urban Renewal Agency and the City of Florence are working with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) on ReVision Florence to provide streetscaping to the Highway 101 corridor.

In 2018, ODOT will be repaving the segment of Highway 101 from the Siuslaw River Bridge to the Highway 126 intersection, and the Urban Renewal Agency has been working on a coordinating streetscape design project.

As the agencies work through the ReVision Florence design process, they are seeking public input on the conceptual design.

## Section of North Fork Road reopens after 2015 landslide

A section of the North Fork Siuslaw Road near Mapleton, just off Highway 36 between mileposts 15.7 and 15.9, has now reopened.

The section of road has been closed after a landslide on Dec. 18, 2015.

The area, located at the bottom of a large hill, was determined to be too unstable to

clear until dry summer conditions reduced the risk of additional slides.

Lane County crews worked this summer to clear the debris and reduce future landslide risk by removing trees above the roadway made unstable by the landslide and in danger of falling when the ground becomes saturated.


