### Permits required for outdoor burning

Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue announced that outdoor burning will be allowed starting Saturday, Oct. 15.

Last year, Siuslaw Valley adopted the Oregon Fire Code and now requires a permitting process for open burning.

Burn permits are now available to the public for those that live outside of the city limits.

There is no open burning allowed in the Florence City limits.

All open burns will require a burn permit. The burn permits are valid for the entire burn season. Each permit has information on what can be burned and who to call to confirm each appropriate burn day. Permits are available online at www.svfr.org and at the main fire station at 2625 Highway 101.
