"We lost to them earlier this season and weren't going to let it happen again," York said. "This year, we really wanted first place and first seed. By the fourth set, I knew we were going to get it done."

A large factor in Siuslaw's advantage came from the team's ability to strike from just about anywhere on the court, as well as outstanding defense by junior libero Maci Wells, who had 25 digs, and senior Brittany Long with 19 digs and 19 assists.

Abby Watkins, also a senior, had 8 digs to go with 13 assists.

Between setting from Long and Watkins, the Vikings were able to keep the Trojans off balance as Siuslaw got additional scoring from freshman Mia Collins, junior Emma Collins and senior Claire Waggoner.

"We really played together as a team this time against Douglas," said Siuslaw coach Jon Hornung. "It was fun to sit back and watch them take over the match as a group, communicating and working together."

The win earned Siuslaw a bye in the first round of state playoff

competition, with Douglas (11-6) hosting Sweet Home (10-9) this Tuesday, Oct. 25.

The Viks will return to Glenn Butler Court on Saturday, Oct. 29, for the second round of 4A state playoffs, more than likely against No. 5-ranked Tillamook — depending on the outcome of today's game between the Cheesemakers and Stayton.
