The mission of Oregon's Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program is to protect individual rights, enhance quality of life, improve care and promote dignity for residents living in Oregon's licensed long-term care facilities.

Ombudsmen are the voice of the consumer. They work to make the long-term care system more responsive to individual resident needs and wishes.

The Office of the Long-Term Care Ombudsman is a free service available to residents, families, facility staff, and the

general public. Ombudsmen respond to a wide variety of resident concerns, including problems with resident care, medications, billing, lost property, meal quality, evictions, guardianships, dignity and respect and care plans. The program serves residents in nursing facilities, residential care facilities, assisted living facilities and adult foster care homes.

The program also provides hundreds of free consultations each year to individuals struggling with the complexities of the long-term care system.
