Just two minutes into the second quarter, the Bruins' drive ended on a 19-yard touchdown pass that put Brookings-Harbor ahead 13-7.

The ensuing PAT went wide, setting into motion a dramatic finish later in the game.

In the meantime, the Vikings scored once more, this time on a quarterback sneak from Brandt that carried him into the end zone from six yards out.

Once again, Foglio's kick was good and, eventually, proved to be the game-winner as the Viking defense held the Bruins scoreless

throughout the entire second half.

During the break, Siuslaw announced its Homecoming Court, which included freshmen princess Trinity Erickson and prince Kiger Johnson, sophomore Princess Samantha Scheer and Prince Landon Robinson, senior Princess Chehalis Stinger and Prince Michael Larson, and Junior Queen Emma Collins and King Trent Reavis.

Coming back into the second half, Brookings-Harbor had its opportunities but Siuslaw was able to thwart its attempts, including a goal line interception by junior Quincy Rusk that stopped the Bruins on 4th-and-4 within Siuslaw's 9-yard line.

Beneath near monsoon-level wind and rain, the Viking defense held on for a narrow 14-13 victory to end the season.

Considering that the Far West League has three teams ranked among the state's top eight — including North Bend (1), South Umpqua (7) and Marshfield (8) — Siuslaw's underclassmen-dominated lineup has a lot to look forward to next season.

This year the entire club fee is \$185 per player, and the fee covers all the tournaments, insurance for practices and tournaments, plus a team sweatshirt, backpack and T-shirt that they get to keep.

Club director Mike Rose said, "We keep our fees extremely low because we have some great fundraisers, like the Viking Cup golf Tournament, plus all of our coaches are volunteers."

The membership fee for most other clubs range from \$500 to a few thousand dollars.

All athletes must pre-register online with www.cevaregion.org and pay a \$10 tryout and deposit fee.

These fees are due at time of online registration; only players making a team will pay the club membership fee.
