Under the threat of rain, Viking senior Celie Mans proved to be an even bigger threat during Thursday's Far West League district meet at Tugman State Park, where she retained the league crown a full 30 seconds ahead of second place.

"I wanted to give a good effort, and Jasmine (Chavez) pushed me the first half," Mans said after finishing the 5,000-meter race in 18 minutes, 45.67 seconds. Not a personal best, but more more than enough to secure the title. "I ran slower than last year, but the conditions made it slower.

"It was more important to run smart than run fast."
