### LRP to present 'Pirates of Penzance'

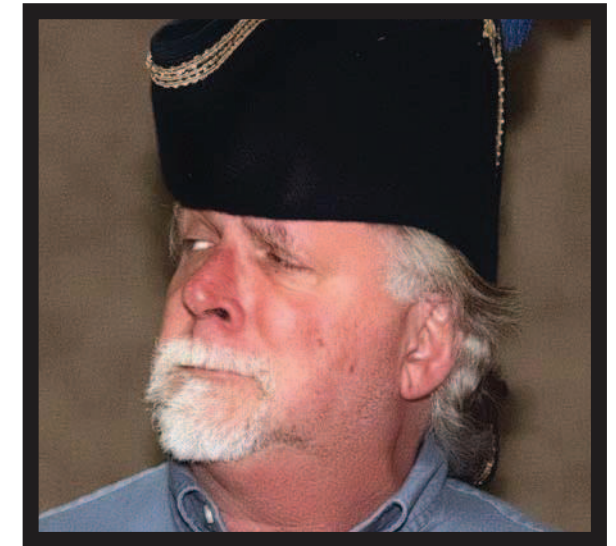
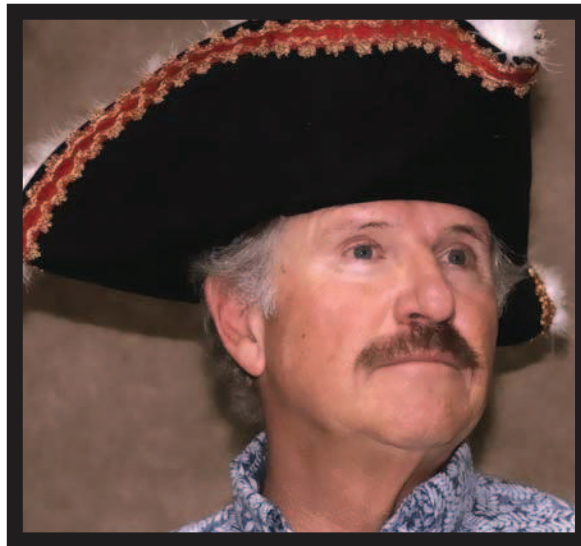
