SPECIAL TRAINING CLASS

Earn state-certified concealed firearm permit

For anyone planning to purchase a handgun for the purpose of carrying a concealed firearm, the state of Oregon requires class and certification prior to applying for a permit.

Oregon residents must apply for a Concealed Handgun Permit (CHP) in the county they live in, and

Oregon does not recognize any other state's CHL permit.

On Nov. 5, NRA certified trainer Shaun Curtain of Firearm Training Northwest will be offering a class providing the necessary Oregon Concealed Carry training certificate. The class will be from 3:30 to

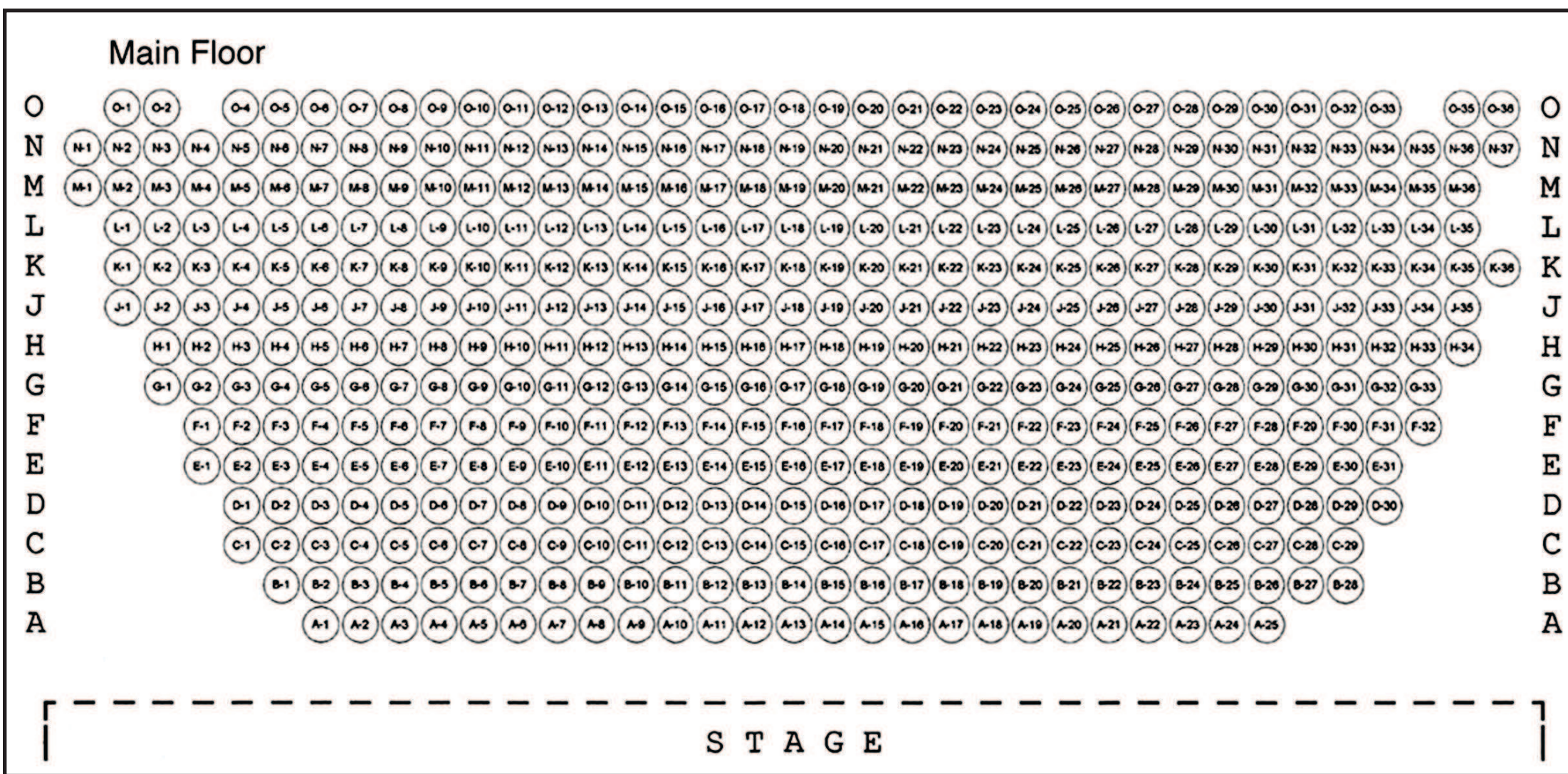
6:30 p.m.

Cost is \$45 (cash or check only; no credit cards).
