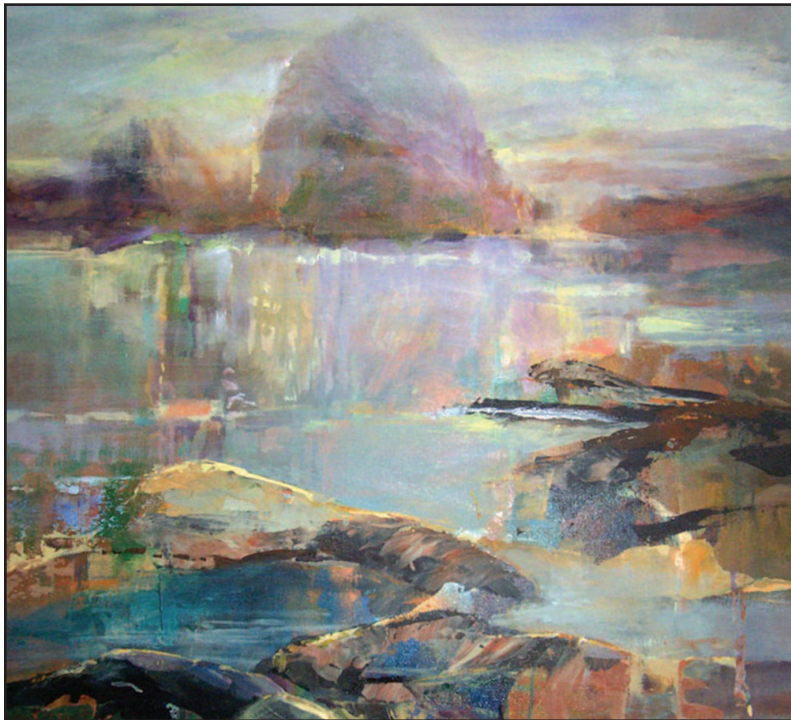


KB GALLERY FEATURING JOANNE CHARTIER ARTWORK
