Viks roll to win at Reedsport

Over the weekend, members of the Siuslaw boys bowling team defeated both Marshfield and North Bend in the Reedsport Tournament finals to nab first place in the 12-team competition.

"The guys did a very good job," said Dusty Anderson, coach and bowling program coordinator for the Vikings. "It was a great team effort."

The Viking boys bowled a total of 24 games and averaged 178 pins per game, earning a spot in the finals. From there, the Viks outbowled Marshfield 342 to 329

in two games, then took on North Bend, defeating the Bulldogs in two games 339 to 323 for the tournament title.

On Sunday, the Lady Vikings were at Cottage Grove, where they competed in a six-team mixed tournament that included boys and girls teams.

Siuslaw finished first among the girls teams and second overall, with the Cottage Grove boys taking first place.

"The girls bowled well and lost to a very good Cottage Grove boys team," said Anderson. "It was a good weekend for all our teams."

MID COAST LAKES:

Rainbow trout stocking is complete along the mid coast. Holdover trout will be available in most lakes. Fishing for the various warm water fish species will slow as water temperatures cool. There are numerous lakes in the Florence area that can provide good opportunity.

SIUSLAW RIVER:

Chinook

The Siuslaw River and bay is open for Chinook salmon. Fishing is slow. Fish are throughout the bay and river. Trolling herring in the lower bay is an effective technique. Eggs and bobber can be productive in the upper bay and river as the season progresses.

ALSEA RIVER: Chinook

The Alsea River and bay is open for Chinook salmon. Fishing is slow. Fish are throughout the bay and river. Eggs and bobber can be productive in the upper bay and river as the season progresses.

Steelhead fishing opens on the Alsea River on Nov. 1. Fish are beginning to enter the mainstem. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

SALMON RIVER:

Chinook

The Salmon River and bay is open for Chinook salmon. Fishing is slow. Fish are throughout the bay and river. Trolling herring in the lower bay is an effective technique. Eggs and bobber can be productive in the upper bay and river as the season progresses. Parking can be limited at Knight Park
