## SOS receives Autzen grant

Siuslaw Outreach Services (SOS) has received a grant for \$3,500 from the Autzen Foundation.

The grant is designated for the SOS Emergency Voucher Fund. This fund is used for a wide variety of emergency situations, with assistance being provided in the form of vouchers redeemable at local businesses.

The Autzen Foundation is based in Portland.

"The timing on this grant was great because we had just used up the last remaining

funds from a previous grant, and this is the season where we typically experience a very large increase in the number of people seeking assistance.

"This past Monday, for example, we had 55 people come to our office, and our average is about 30," said Executive Director David Wiegand.

In 2015, SOS provided services to 2,902 individuals, a new record and an increase of over 10 percent from 2014.

**BALDWIN**—Eric Randolph Baldwin, 61, peacefully passed away at home the morning of Oct. 13, after a hard-fought battle with cancer.

Born in Hollister, Calif., to Cedric and Shirley Baldwin, Eric was the middle child between sister Loretta Elaine and brother John Ethan. The family spent its early years in La Selva Beach, Calif., while Cedric was stationed at Ft. Ord finishing his U.S. Army career.

After retirement, the family moved to the Willamette Valley of Oregon, eventually settling in Lowell. Eric graduated Lowell High in 1972 and enlisted in the Army, where he

was assigned to a tank squadron in Germany.

After an honorable discharge, he returned to Oregon, worked as a diving instructor and attended school for aircraft maintenance. He earned his pilot's license, beginning his love of all things aircraft.

In 1979, Eric began open cockpit rides in his first airplane, a 1943 Fairchild PT23. In 1984, he began work as a Douglas DC3 air cargo pilot based out of Seattle, Wash., then transferred to United Airlines at Denver International.

Eric was inspired by his maternal grandfather Carl Raymond Bucklen's legacy as renowned pilot during 1920s-40s. Eric's experience expanded with The Commemorative Air Force piloting the B29 Superfortress "Fi'Fi," the B24 Liberator, and Grumman TBM Avenger torpedo bombers.

His interest for flying for airshows and events lead to owning and operating EB Air LLC with his 1941 Boeing Stearman.

Eric retired from United Airlines to live in Florence.

He is preceded in death by his parents and sister.

Eric is survived and lovingly remembered by his brother, John Baldwin of Oregon; his wife Linda of Oregon; his only son Michael Baldwin with

wife-to-be Ranelle Franklin; grandsons Deggan, Christian and Brinon of California; niece Erin Zysett of Oregon; nephew John Baldwin with wife Katie; and great-nephew and nieces, Samuel, Elliyah and Adaline of Oregon.

Along with aviation, Eric's hobbies included scuba diving, riding motorcycles, cruising his vintage cars and restoring classic antiques.

His love of family, the sky, the ocean and his cats will never be forgotten.
