

Actors invited to audition for LRP's 'Moon Over Buffalo'

Last Resort Players (LRP) will begin auditions for Ken Ludwig's "Moon Over Buffalo" Saturday, Dec. 17, and Sunday, Dec. 18, from 1 to 4 p.m. at Florence Events Center, 715 Quince St.

In the madcap comedy tradition of "Lend me a Tenor," the hilarious "Moon Over Buffalo" centers on George and Charlotte Hay, fading stars of the 1950s. At the moment, they are playing two shows in rep in Buffalo, NY, with five actors.

On the brink of a disastrous split-up caused by George's dalliance with a young ingenue, they receive word that they might just have one last shot at stardom: Frank Capra is coming to town to see their matinee, and if likes what he sees, he might cast them in his movie remake of "The Scarlet Pimpernel."
