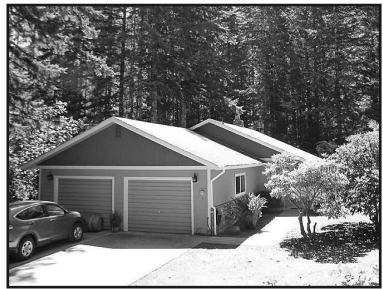

Conservation and Development (CPRCD) by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. This grant will support an effort with the Siuslaw National Forest, CPRCD, Save the Riders Dunes and other local partners to identify and eradicate inva-

sive species on the Oregon dunes and build capacity for broad scale dunes ecosystem restoration projects into the future.

This \$82,000 grant will support restoration of 200 acres of sand dunes within the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area (ODNRA), protect critical habitat for threatened and endangered species, provide

trainings for coastal communities to learn how to detect and control invasive species on the dunes, and establish a network of partners all working towards the mutual goal of dunes restoration.

We're so thrilled about the opportunities these grants will provide to work with our partners to address critical restoration needs up and down the

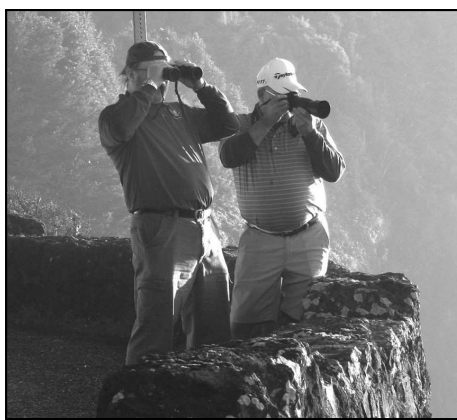
Oregon coast," said Jerry Ingersoll, Siuslaw forest supervisor. "We have some big challenges out there. By joining forces with our partners to tackle them, we have the ability to make great strides in improving outcomes for fish and wildlife, and people who live, work and play on the Oregon coast."

Highway 101 overlooks.

"We've already seen the first migrating gray whales in the past few days and we expect another excellent winter whale watching week," said Luke Parsons, Whale Watching Center ranger. "Last winter our volunteers helped people see more than 1,600 gray whales plus a pod of orcas and some humpback whales spotted on the central coast. "You never know what you're going to see while you're whale watching, but that's half the fun." Whale enthusiasts and visi-

tors to the coast are invited to watch for migrating whales with trained volunteers during this week's annual winter migration period.

Volunteers will be stationed

at the designated sites from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. each day to help people spot gray whales heading south to Mexico.

Whale watchers search for spouts at one of 24 designated whale watching spots along the Oregon coast. Visitors will also learn about whale migration and feeding habits. The winter migration typically lasts from now until mid-January. A map of the watch sites is

available online at www.whale-spoken.org. Camping, including yurts and cabins, is available at state parks along the coast by visiting www.oregon-state-parks.org and checking availability and making a reservation.

OPRD reminds visitors to check www.oregonstateparks.org and www.tripcheck.com for weather-related alerts and closures before heading to the coast.

Be safe and aware of winter storms and high waves, and respect beach closures, stay off the sand and watch storms from an elevated location.
