Vik grapplers show well at Alsea, ready for home meet

Viking junior wrestler Richard Huff improved to 15-3 for the season after sweeping the 120-pound bracket at the Alsea Bay Classic in Waldport on Saturday.

Huff was one of three Siuslaw wrestlers to finish in the top four, with seniors Nick Steinman (170 pounds) and Kainan Lane (285 pounds) finished fourth and second, respectively.

At 120 pounds, Huff had two pins and a major decision at the meet, dom-

inating his weight class and winning the title round over Calvin Ruth of Newport in just 17 seconds by pin.

Steinman finished the day at 2-2 for fourth place, earning 11 team points

MID COAST LAKES:

Holdover trout will be available in most lakes. Fishing for the various warm water fish species will slow as water temperatures cool. There are numerous lakes in the Florence area that can provide good opportunity.

SIUSLAW RIVER:

Steelhead

The Siuslaw River and bay is closed to Chinook salmon.

Fishing is slow.

The Siuslaw River and Lake Cr. are open for steelhead fishing. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

ALSEA RIVER:

Chinook, steelhead

Steelhead fishing opened on the Alsea River and listed tributaries. Fishing is fair when river conditions are favorable.

Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

SALMON RIVER:

Steelhead

The Salmon River opened for wild and hatchery steelhead is open. Wild winter steelhead can be retained on the Salmon River.

Daily and annual bag limit on wild winter steelhead are 1/day and 3/year. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

SILETZ RIVER AND BAY: Steelhead

Winter steelhead opportunities are improving as more fish move through the mainstem. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.
