Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue, Western Lane EMS and the trauma team at Peace Harbor Medical Center worked tirelessly to save the life of a friend, mentor and colleague, but were unable to resuscitate him.

He was a 29-year veteran of the Siuslaw Valley Fire Department when he retired in 2010 as a Battalion Chief. He is a true loss to the community as he was also a Siuslaw High

School football coach and part of both state championship teams — 1981 as an athlete and 2006 as a coach on the sidelines.

After graduating with the Siuslaw Class of 1983, he joined the U.S. Navy, where he served in the military for four years.

He is survived by his son, Kristopher; mother Ardith; brother Charles (Chic); and sister Kristi Bower.

He is also the father to his stepchildren Katie Burch, Nicholas Burch, Sara Crook and Mary Richard.

Beyond that, he has five nieces and nephews along with seven great-nieces and nephews that loved him very much. In his final days, he was glad to be back in his home town.
