Friday at 8 p.m. on **KLSR**

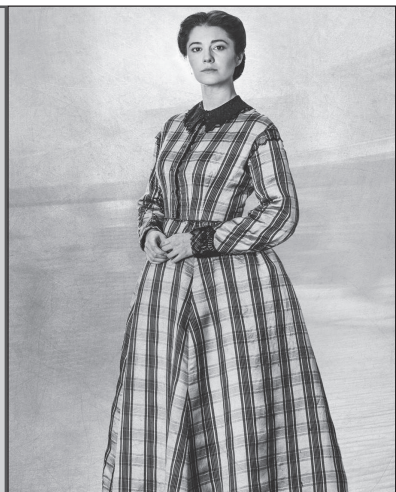
