## Local author to speak in Yachats

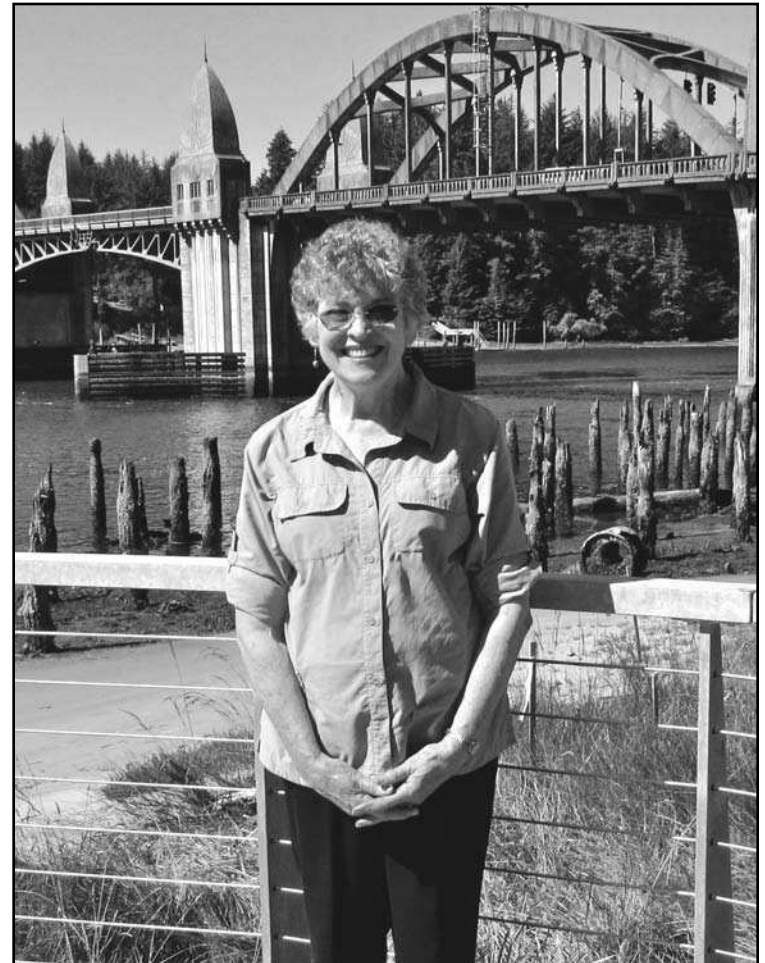
On Saturday, Feb. 4, the Yachats Academy of Arts and Sciences will host Judy Fleagle in a program about the Historic Coastal Bridges.
