## VIK TEAMS FALL TO LANCERS

Siuslaw boys basketball coach Dylan Perry said that getting a win at South Umpqua is always hard, and last Friday's 11-point loss to the 1-5 Lancers underscored that statement.

Heading into the matchup, Siuslaw was in a three-way tie for second place along Marshfield and Douglas, a situation that continues thanks to an upset

over Marshfield by Brookings-Harbor that same night, along with an expected win by North Bend at Douglas.

Against the Lancers, Siuslaw's traditionally ironclad zone defense was unable to keep South Umpqua from hitting from the perimeter, forcing the Viks out of their normal set. The result was open looks for the Lancers as well as early foul trouble for the Viks that

## Siuslaw wrestlers nab top-six seeds for district

During last weekend's two-day Cottage Grove Invitational, junior Richard Huff (113 lbs.) and sophomore Riley Jennings (152 lbs.) each advanced to Saturday's quarterfinals on pins during the tournament's opening rounds on Friday.

The Viks had a total of six wrestlers entered in the meet, with three — sen-

iors Joaquin Cervantes (138 lbs.), Jesus Sierra (145 lbs.) and Nick Steinman (160 lbs.) — eliminated by the end of day one, and freshman Matthew Horrillo (285 lbs.) reaching consolation after pinning three of his four opponents.

By the end of finals on Saturday, Huff had nabbed the Special District 3's top seed after taking the 33-school Cottage Grove Invitational title at 113 pounds.

Three other Vikings will enter district competition seeded among the top six, including Jennings seeded at No. 5 in the 152-pound class after knocking off the No. 3 seed at Cottage Grove.

"That's one of the highest placements achieved by a Viking sophomore at this invitational," said Siuslaw coach Neil Wartnik.

### MID COAST LAKES:

Holdover trout will be available in most lakes. Fishing for the various warm water fish species will slow as water temperatures cool. There are numerous lakes in the Florence area that can provide good opportunity.

### SIUSLAW RIVER:

**Steelhead**  
The Siuslaw River and bay is closed to Chinook salmon.

Fishing is slow.

The Siuslaw River and Lake Cr. are open for steelhead fishing. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

### ALSEA RIVER:

**Chinook, steelhead**  
Steelhead fishing opened on the Alsea River and listed tributaries. Fishing is fair when river conditions are favorable.

Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

### SALMON RIVER:

**Steelhead**  
The Salmon River opened for wild and hatchery steelhead is open. Wild winter steelhead can be retained on the Salmon River.

Daily and annual bag limit on wild winter steelhead are 1/day and 3/year. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

### SILETZ RIVER AND BAY: Steelhead

Winter steelhead opportunities are improving as more fish move through the mainstem. Casting spinners, drifting bait or
