Port seeks to fill three open Commissioner seats

The Port of Siuslaw has announced there will be three Port Commissioner positions on the ballot for the May 16, 2017 Special District Election. The positions are available for the usual four-year term. Those terms will begin July 1, 2017 and end June 30, 2021.

Port of Siuslaw Commissioners are required to be registered voters who are residents of the Port district. The district covers approximately 700 square miles of the Siuslaw River watershed, including the communities of Florence, Dunes City and Mapleton.

The watershed extends upriver to Walton, Lorane and Blachly. The Port of Siuslaw is a special district, authorized in 1909 under Oregon law, ORS Chapter 777.

Persons interested in filing to be on the ballot for any of the open Commission seats need to file with Lane County Elections no later than 5 p.m.

March 16. The Candidate Manual and forms are available on the Oregon Secretary of State's

Interested candidates can file with Lane County Elections by either paying a \$10 fee or by circulating a petition to collect signatures and submitting signatures to the County for verification. The Lane County Election office is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.


