## Rotary to offer two \$2,000 'Education Fellowships'

The Florence Rotary Club's Continuing Professional Education Fellowship program is offering two \$2,000 fellowships to support local people who serve our community.

The simple application is due by Friday, May 5, at 4 p.m. Eight years after the Rotary Professional Education grant first began, more than a dozen local teachers and nonprofit professionals have received training and education. Here are some of the results:

- A middle school science teacher attended a graduate-level course at Portland State University focused on engineering and design education.

- An elementary school teacher who was struggling to engage the highest and lowest achievers in her classroom used the funding to attend a national conference about using tablets to manage differentiated learning. This approach advocates the use of small workstations throughout a classroom where students can learn in different ways - using a computer or tablet, touching or interacting with objects, engaging in dis-

ussion, or pursuing individual study. A counselor received training to teach women and children how to deal with and prevent domestic abuse. Anyone engaged in serving the community is eligible, and complete details about the program are available online.
