## Tatum receives Kaiser Permanente scholarship

Senior Destinie Tatum of Siuslaw High School has been awarded a health education scholarship from Kaiser Permanente. The nonprofit announced that the Kaiser Permanente Health Care Career Scholarship program has awarded \$39,000 to Lane County students planning careers in health-related fields. The local awards are part of awards in Oregon and Washington totaling more than \$535,000 for 166 students. The awards recognize the positive relationship between education and health, as well as the value to the community of helping diverse and economically disadvantaged students pursue careers in health. Tatum is eligible for renewal of the scholarship in future years.

## WLCF TO AWARD \$3,000 HEALTH CARE SCHOLARSHIP

Western Lane Community Foundation (WLCF) will award its annual \$3,000 Arlis Ulman Health Careers Scholarship to a Lane Community College, Florence campus, student this summer.
