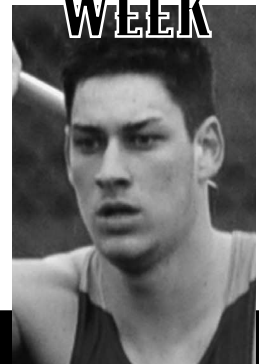

### OF THE WEEK



Trent Reavis



The junior athlete will compete in three different events at this week's OSAA State Track and Field Finals after winning two Far West League championships and finishing second in another event. Reavis was 1/2 inch short of a school record with his winning toss of 52' 1/2" to win the shot put; he claimed victory in the discus with a mark of 150' 11"; and was second in the javelin with a personal best throw of 172' 6".

### Honorable Mention Destinie Tatum

Honorable mention goes to Destinie Tatum who will defend her state title in the 800 meters after winning that event at the Far West District meet in North Bend in 2:25.76. Tatum also ran a leg in the 1st place 4x400 relay team.

In the hurdles, Graham ran season-best times for second place in both the 100 meters (17.09) and 300 meters (50.79). She will run both races at state. Junior thrower Trent Reavis qualified for state in three events after claiming wins in both the

shot put (52-00.5 for a PR) and discus (150-11), and finishing second in the javelin with a personal record at 172-06. Senior Carissa Oliver won the shot put and discus for the girls, throwing 41-05 and 136-05, respectively. The state meet begins this Friday, May 19, with Reavis the first Viking on the schedule with the discus at 9 a.m., followed by

after being sick the entire week," said Longo. In the javelin, junior Tanner Wilson threw for the win at 128-02, then placed second in the dis-

cus at 99-09 on his final throw. Freshman Nathen Roane also advanced to state, landing a person best on his last throw in the javelin at 121-10 for second place behind Wilson. "They both surprised a lot of people by breaking form in those events," said Longo. For the girls, senior Josi Hays swept the throws category, winning the shot put (30-07), discus

(89-10) and javelin (94-07), advancing to state in all three events. "Four athletes competing in eight events at state isn't bad for a school our size," said Longo.
