Summer reading and craft programs begin at Library

"Build a Better World" is the theme of Siuslaw Public Library's Summer Reading Program, which began June 1. Patrons of all ages are invited to try something new this summer — at home, in the community, throughout the country, and around the globe.

Read a new book, try a new craft, meet new people and learn about new places. Patrons can do all of these at the library this summer.

First of the scheduled Adult Summer Reading Program events is the annual Endowment Book presentation on June 9, at 1 p.m., at the main branch of the library in the Bromley Room.

This hour-long program begins with an introduction by Adult Services Librarian Kevin Mitge, followed by an opportunity to browse the new additions to the library's collection.

Next, on June 17, try your hand at a new craft. Rosie Hill, expert "Tangler," will conduct a 90-minute Zentangle session beginning at 1 p.m. in the Bromley Room.

Hill said what she loves about Zentangle is "how it is

successful for everyone, even those who think they aren't artistic."

If you can write your name, you can draw Zentangles and experience the joy of creativity and artful expression.

What is Zentangle?

It is an easy-to-learn, relaxing and fun way to create beautiful, abstract images by drawing structured patterns, called "tangles."

It is a mindful approach to drawing that is suitable and satisfying for all ages and abil-

ities.

This introductory class will provide background information on the Zentangle phenomenon. Workshops "What I love about Several Tangles," will be taught, and at least one Zentangle will be completed in class.

Supplies necessary to complete a Zentangle will be provided. Registration is required as the class is limited to 25 people. Interested tanglers can register at the reference desk at the main library in Florence.

Both events are free and open to the public, although the Zentangle session is limited to a certain number of participants.

The endowment book event will appeal to anyone looking for a new good book.

Zentangle will appeal to those who want to explore this fun unique art technique.
