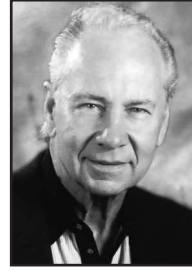
Jean traveled with the Hormel Girls Sales and Entertainment Troop for six years before going to work for ABC Radio and Television.
