Classes focus on the restoration work that is being done to keep the watershed healthy.

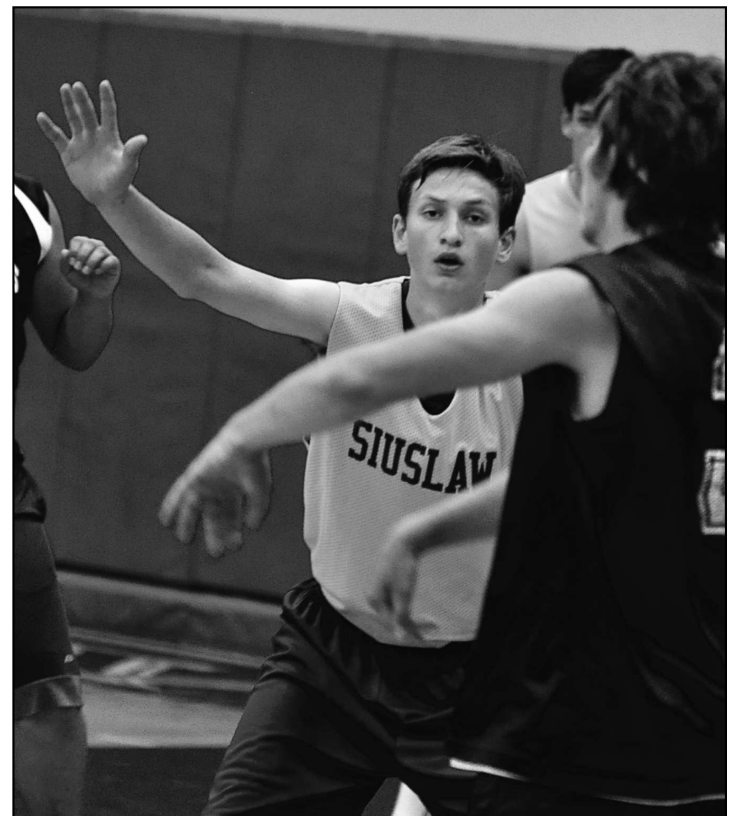
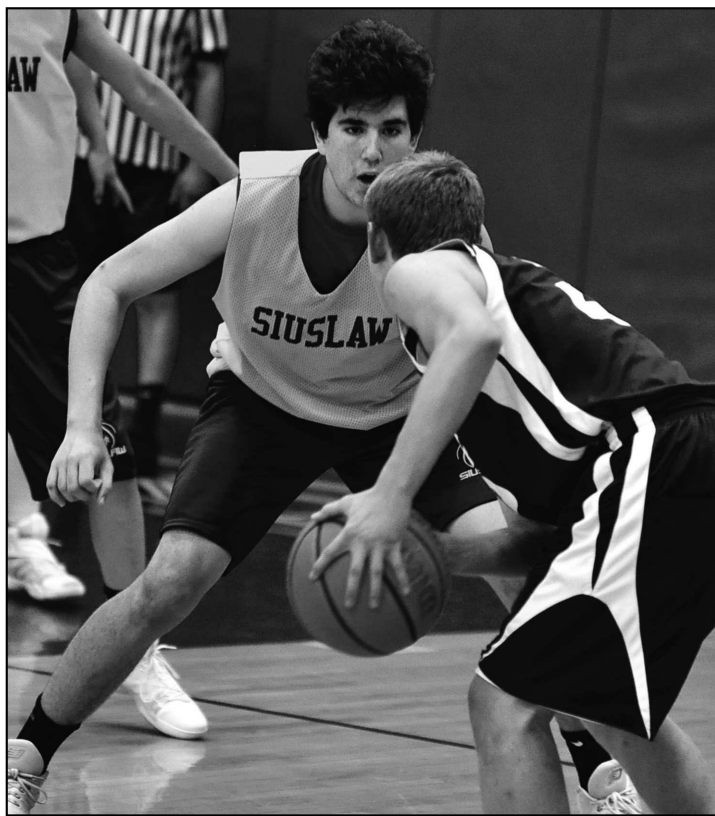
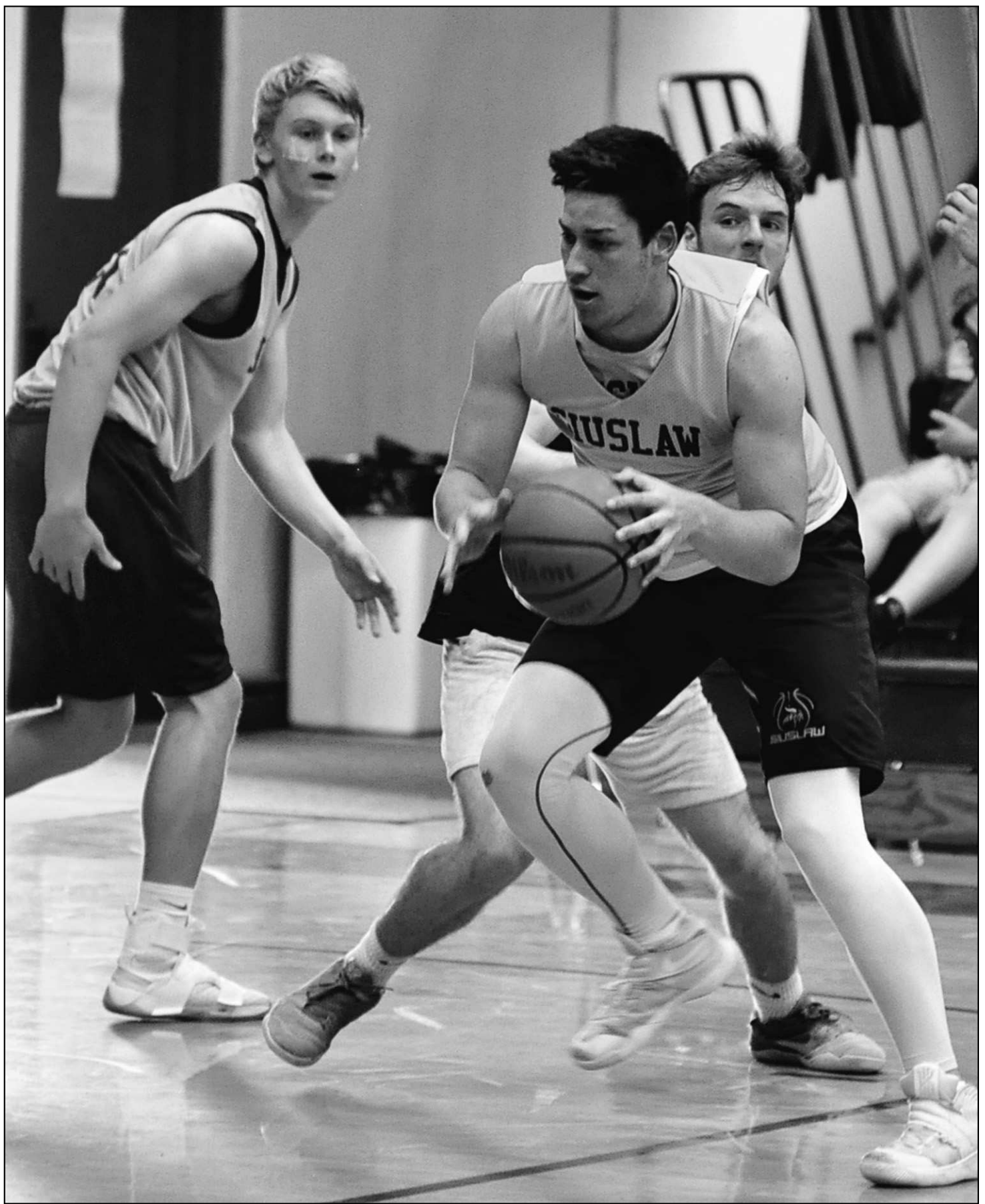

Those 18 and under were admitted free.

"Summer basketball is a great time to embrace playing

the game and having fun," Perry said. "We wanted to make that experience available to kids of all ages."

Summer basketball continues for Siuslaw, which played last night at Newport and will participate in the Seaside Summer Basketball Tournament along with 19 other teams this weekend (June 23-25).

June 30 through July 2, Siuslaw will participate in the Marshfield Southwestern Oregon Community College Basketball Tournament.

The Siuslaw varsity team includes incoming seniors Trent Reavis, Kyle King, Jared Brandt, Jake Hickson, Johnny Rollin, Evan Johnson and Dylan McGallian.

Perry led the Vikings to the state playoffs for the first time in more than a decade in his first year as head coach last season.
