## Concert to benefit PHPH Palliative Care program

Palliative care is an approach that improves the quality of life of patients and their families facing the problems associated with life-threatening illness, through the prevention and relief of suffering by means of early identification and treatment of pain.

It also addresses physical, psychosocial and spiritual aspects. It is the care that a patient receives when they don't qualify for Home Health and are not ready for Hospice.

On June 30, at 7 p.m., a special folk music concert sponsored by Peace Harbor Medical Center and hosted at the Florence Events Center will raise funds for this unique program and its expansion of services beyond Florence and into Mapleton and the other up-river communities.

To do this, philanthropy will be a major funding source due to the lack of reimbursements from most insurance providers as well as Medicare and Medicaid.

The concert won't be "selling" tickets but will be requesting a donation of at least \$25 per person.

Among those performing will be:

**Mike and Carleen McCornack:** From Eugene, the duo has shared their musical artistry with grateful audiences for more than four decades. From coffee houses to concert halls, the McCornacks' beautifully crafted songwriting comes to life in their music with superb vocal harmony and sparkling guitar accompaniment that touches the heart and never fails to tickle the funny bone. They are award-winning songwriters and two-time winners of the Florence Winter Folk Festival's People's Choice Award.

**Kray Van Kirk:** A singer-songwriter delivering performances that the Borderline Folk Club in New York called "...what every singer-songwriter should aspire to," his creative writing, guitar artistry and wonderful voice leaves audiences asking for more.

His warm and intimate concerts on six- and 12-string guitars have received critical praise from the house concert circuit to festivals and larger stages.
