## On the Bite

**MID COAST LAKES**  
Olalla Reservoir has been stocked with over 50 surplus summer steelhead from the Siletz Falls trap, so far this season. These fish get fairly active in the lake and offer a unique fishing experience.

Once in the lake they are considered "trout" and do not require a Combined Angling Tag.

Anglers are reminded, however, that only one trout per day over 20 inches may be retained, and these fish will almost all be in that size range.

Mid Coast lakes been stocked with trout throughout the spring. Trout stocking is over until the fall but there still should be fish around to catch. Water temps are great and fish should be hungry, so go catch them.

**SIUSLAW RIVER: Trout**

**SILETZ RIVER: Steelhead, Chinook, trout**

The Siletz River opened for wild Chinook on April 1 (1 per day and 2 per season). Spring Chinook and summer steelhead are being caught, and fishing should continue to improve. Recycling hatchery summer steelhead from the Siletz Falls trap has ended for the season.

Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

Trout is season open. Remember the limit on streams and rivers is two per day over 8-inches.

**WILSON RIVER: Steelhead, Spring Chinook, trout**

Spring Chinook fishing has been slow on the Wilson.

Summer steelhead fishing has picked up a bit on
