

# Registration has begun for annual Prefontaine Run

Applications are now being accepted for the 2017 Prefontaine Memorial Run.

The 10,000-meter road run is slated for 10 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 16, in downtown Coos Bay, and is held in conjunction with the Bay Area Fun Festival, Coos Bay's largest annual community celebration.

This year's Prefontaine Run has been designated as the Road Runners Club of America (RRCA) Oregon State Championship 10K race.

RRCA Championship medals will be presented to the top overall masters (40-49), grandmaster (50-59) and senior

grandmaster (60 and older) male and female winners.

A stand-alone 5K high school crosscountry team competition will start at 9:45 a.m. Participating teams last year included Brookings-Harbor, Cascade Christian, Douglas, Grants Pass, Henley, Hidden Valley, Marshfield, North Bend, Reedsport, St. Mary's, Sutherlin and Toledo.

Awards for the open 10K Pre Run will be given in five-year age groups. First through third place finishers in each division will receive awards.

The awards ceremony for both races

will be held adjacent to the finish line on the Prefontaine Track at Pirate Stadium.

The entry fee is \$30 if made prior to Sept. 13, and \$40 thereafter. High School team competitors must register on athletic.net and receive a discounted registration fee.

All race entrants will received a Tshirt especially designed to commemorate the Pre Run.

### MID COAST LAKES

Olalla Reservoir has been stocked with over 50 surplus summer steelhead from the Siletz Falls trap, so far this season. These fish get fairly active in the lake and offer a unique fishing experience.

Once in the lake they are considered "trout" and do not require a Combined Angling Tag.

Anglers are reminded, however, that only one trout per day over 20 inches may be retained, and these fish will almost all be in that size range.

Mid Coast lakes been stocked with trout throughout the spring. Trout stocking is over until the fall but there still should be fish around to catch. Water temps are great and fish should be hungry, so go catch them.

The Siletz River opened for wild Chinook on April 1 (1 per day and 2 per season). Spring Chinook and summer steelhead are being caught, and fishing should continue to improve. Recycling hatchery summer steelhead from the Siletz Falls trap has ended for the season. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.


