ROTARY'S INTERACT DONATES TO ECUADOR MISSION



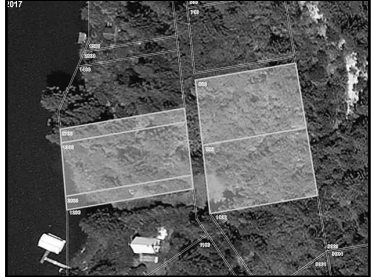

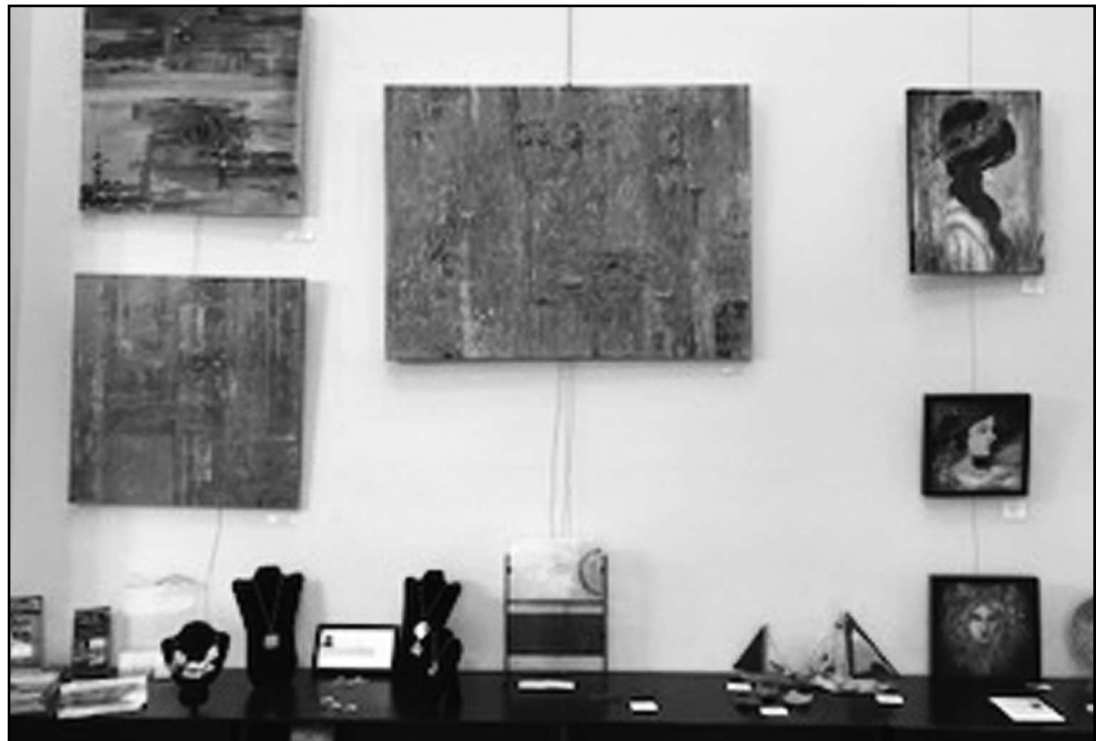


Florence Chamber features three artists for October
