Genealogy enthusiasts discuss Civil War mementos

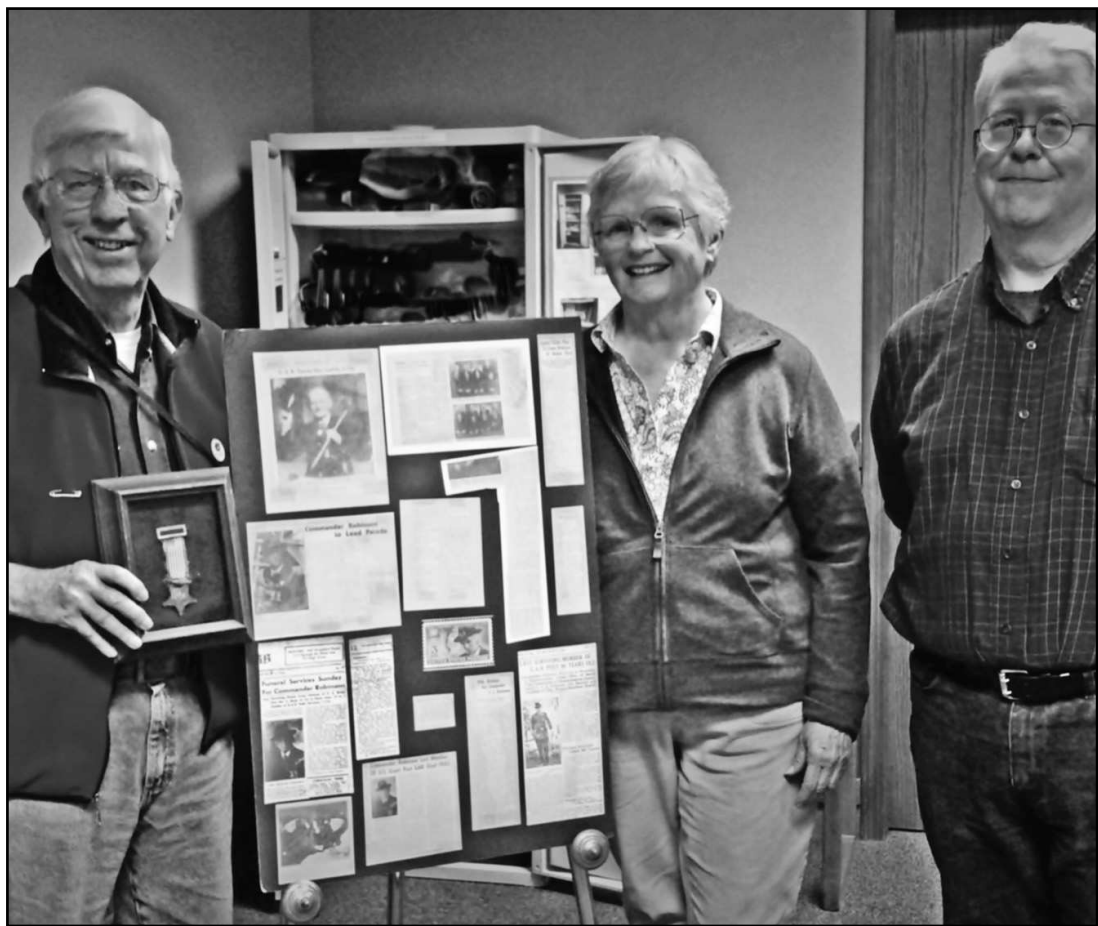
Siuslaw Genealogy Society President Mike Allen was also a presenter at the September meeting of the genealogy group. Allen's program featured three members telling of their research on relatives who were members of The Grand Army of the Republic. Known as the GAR, it was a patriotic organization of veterans who fought for the Union Army in the American Civil War. The organization ceased to exist when the last member died in 1956.

The Genealogy Society provides a monthly program on topics of interest to persons using genealogy to explore family history. The public is invited to these presentations.

The November speaker will be Kevin Mittge, the Adult Services Librarian at the Siuslaw Public Library. Mittge has been "doing" genealogy for 40 years.

His lecture will discuss "trees" on Ancestry.com.

This includes: how to create a tree, how to edit and add

information, deciding whether a tree should be public or private, inviting people to private trees, linking a tree to a person's Ancestry DNA results, using trees to determine relationships from DNA results,

syncing trees to genealogy software, saving tree data, deleting trees and more.

This presentation will be from 7 to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 15, in the Bromley Room of the Siuslaw

Public Library, which is located at 1460 Ninth St. The public is invited.
