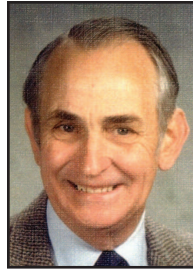

Steve and Claire moved to the coast in Florence, where they built a beautiful home at the mouth of the Siuslaw River, overlooking the Pacific Ocean. After 12 years of enjoying sea breezes, they moved to McMinnville, Ore., and Hillside Brookdale Community, where they were extremely happy.

Steve and Claire enjoyed numerous travels during their married life including Mexico, Hawaii, Canada, England, portions of Europe and Alaska, to
