I Am Elizabeth Smart

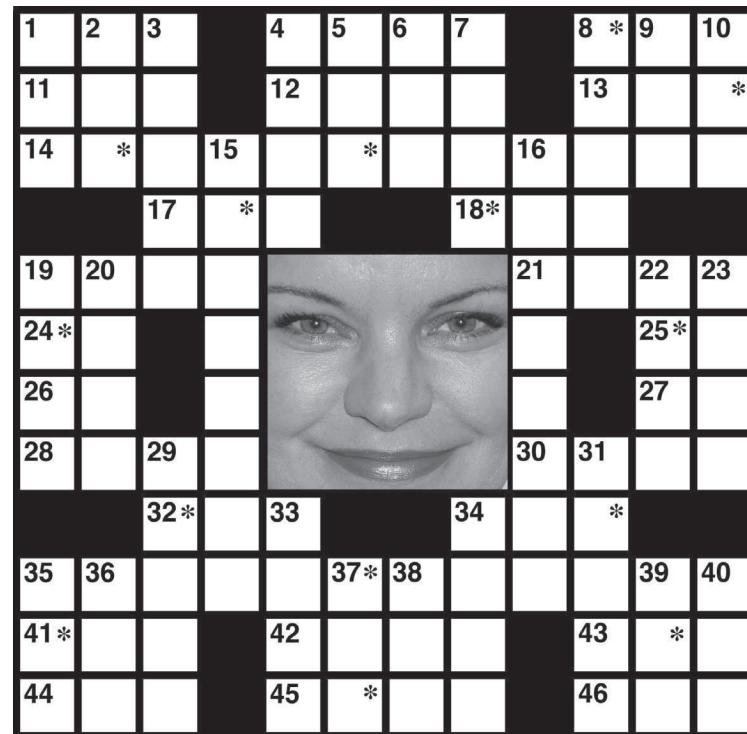
Saturday at 8 p.m., 12:02 a.m. on **LIFE**

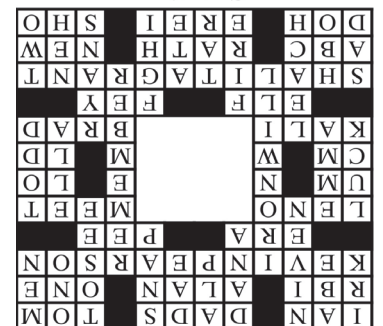
