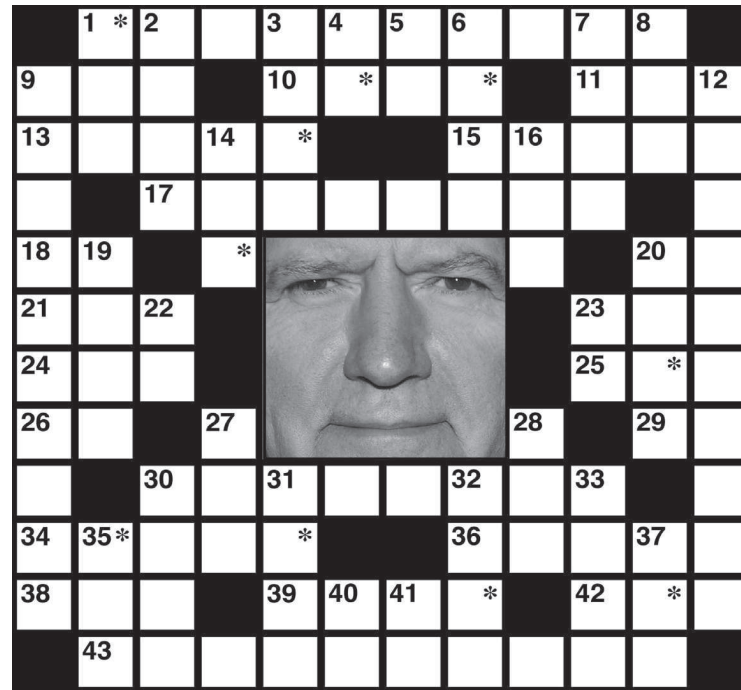


crossword fun

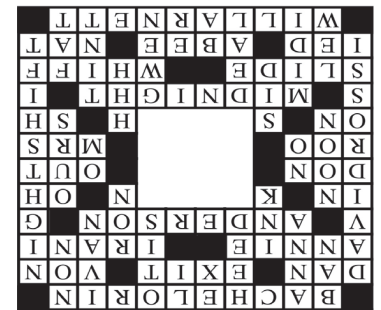

Thursday at 9 a.m., 2 p.m. on **KGW, KOBI, KMTR**

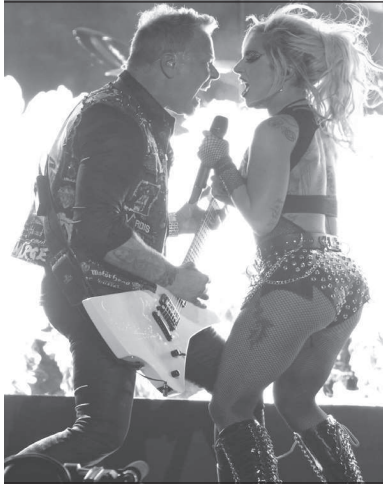
