Museum offers class on Oregon Military Heritage

The Oregon Coast Military Museum will be offering a six-part series in conjunction with Lane Community College's Continuing Education program winter term.

The classes will focus on the impacts of military heritage in Oregon, beginning with the Civil War and continuing through the current conflicts and "War on Terrorism."

Some sessions will feature guest speakers.

Sessions will include: the heritage of the United States' military branches; Oregon's military involvement prior to statehood and in the Civil War, the Indian Wars and World War I, including the Bonus War; General synopsis of World War II and Oregon's involvement during the war; the Cold War; Vietnam War and other conflicts up until 1980; and modern conflicts from 1980 to present.

The classes will be held in the museum's theater and seating is limited.

Classes will be held Wednesday evenings from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. through January, February and March of 2018.
