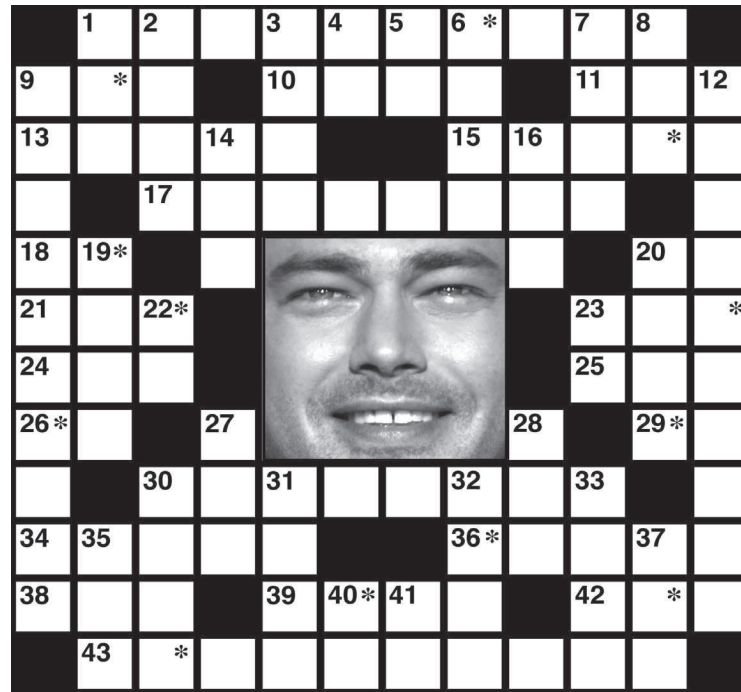


crossword fun


