Deadline for Submission is Thursday, Feb. 18.

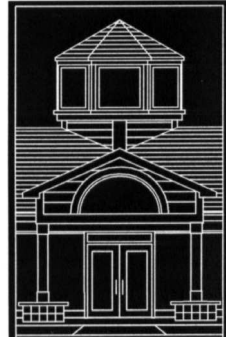
