"From the start, the Lady Vikings let the rest of the field know they were there to win," said Dusty Anderson, coach and program coordinator.

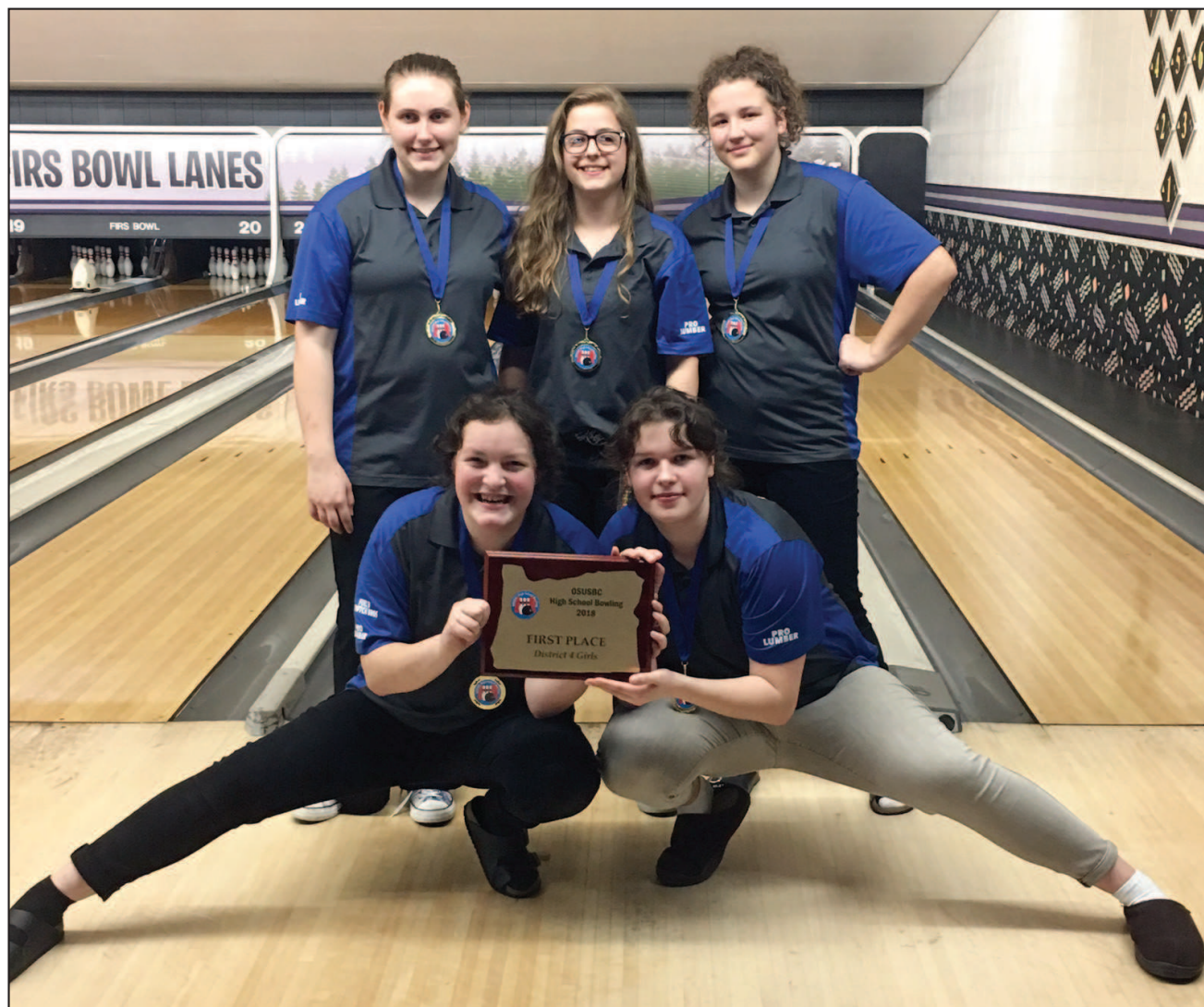

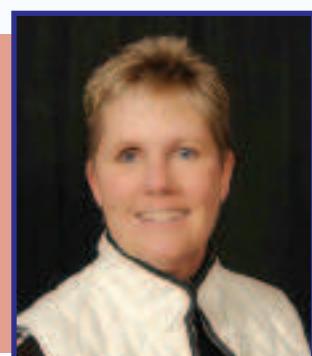
