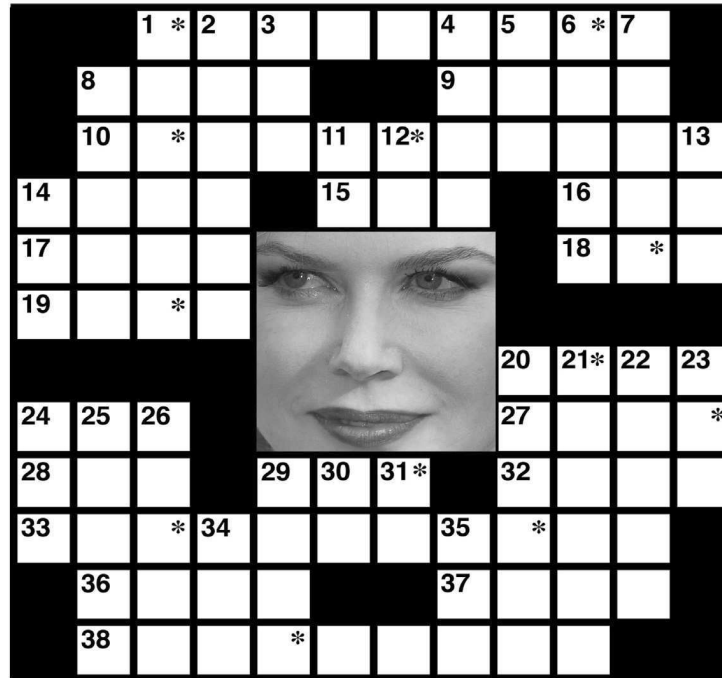

In the midseason finale, they saw Rick's (Andrew Lincoln) son bitten by one of the walkers, which generally signals imminent death. And it's not as if Rick doesn't have enough on his plate already: His attack on Negan (Jeffrey Dean Morgan) was a bust that left devastation in its aftermath.
