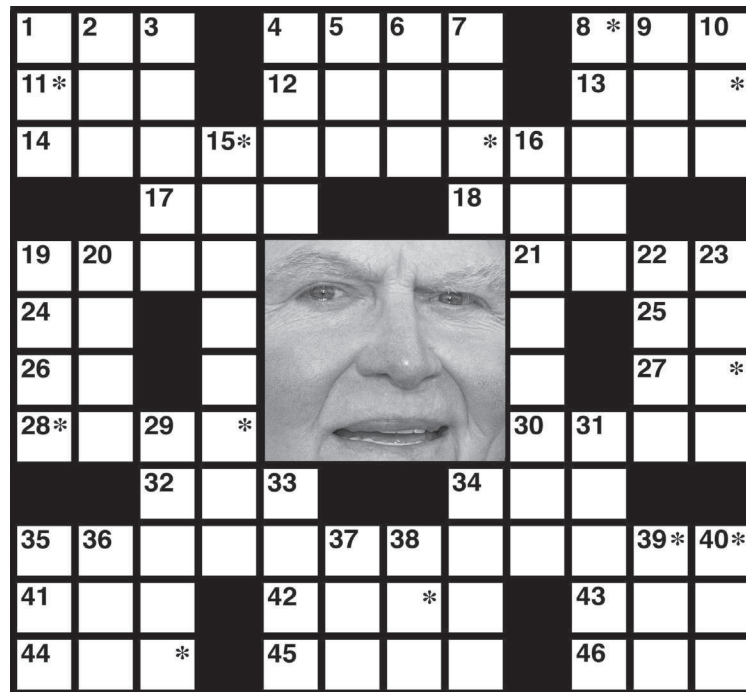


crossword fun

Magic is very much on the menu in this new drama series, as Jack Cutmore-Scott ("Cooper Barrett's Guide to Surviving Life") plays a superstar illusionist who has a major fall from grace. He then uses his skills to help FBI agents (Amaury Nolasco, Laila Robins) capture particularly evasive criminals. Vinnie Jones and Lenora Cichlow also star in the show, created by Chris Fedak ("Chuck") and also including Greg Berlanti and Martin Gero ("Blindspot") among its executive producers.

Comparisons to "Glee" are inevitable, but it should be noted that this grittier drama is based on a true story. Josh Radnor ("How I Met Your Mother") has the central role as a teacher who becomes the supervisor of his school's theater department in the series' premiere, portending big changes for the facility — and also for many people in the surrounding community. The show also features Auli'i Cravalho ("Moana"), Rosie Perez and Marley Shelton in its "Pilot."




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
