In spite of a rainy weekend, the

Viking baseball team was able to take to the diamond at Newport High School’s turf field for a two-day invitational that began Monday.

Siuslaw came into the tournament in search of a win after losing its first two nonleague match-ups last week, including a narrow 1-run loss to a late-rallying Sutherlin.

But Monday’s pair of losses — to

Dallas and Estacada — were anything but close after being outscored 41-5 between the two games.

“Dallas was a strong-hitting team, but we compounded problems with some errors,” said Siuslaw coach Thomas Shinn. “You can’t give extra outs to a quality team like Dallas.”

- BEST BETS FOR FISHING
- ‘Tis the season for spring Chinook on the Columbia, Willamette, Rogue and Umpqua rivers.

• The Ana River is putting out limits of 12- to 18-inch trout.

• Speaking of limits, most ocean anglers have been getting their limits of lingcod.

• This can be a great time of year to pick up a steelhead on the Imnaha and Umatilla rivers.

• Trout are being stocked in dozens of places — check the zone reports for locations.

BE ALERT TO FISHING REGULATION CHANGES:

Fishing regulations can change during the season, especially during popular salmon seasons. To stay on top of the changes, click the yellow “alert” button at the top of the “Home” and “Fishing” pages. You also can check for any regulation updates at the top of each zone of the Recreation Report.

SPRING CHINOOK

Some anglers wait all year for spring Chinook season, and reports of early fish being caught are coming in from the lower Columbia, North Umpqua and lower Rogue rivers. To follow any in-season regulation changes on the Columbia River, check out the regulation update section at the top of the Columbia Zone of the Recreation Report.

MID COAST LAKES:

Stocking of mid coast lakes began in February.

Siltcoos Lagoon was not stocked the week of Feb. 5 due to low levels of dissolved oxygen.

Fish scheduled for Siltcoos Lagoon were stocked in Cleawox Lake instead.

SIUSLAW RIVER: Steelhead

Winter steelhead fishing has improved. Rain over the weekend has raised the river level and got fish moving again. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

ALSEA RIVER: Steelhead

Winter steelhead has picked up throughout the river. Rain over the weekend has raised the river level and got fish moving again. A mix of wild and hatchery fish are being caught. Casting spinners,
