The Easter Egg Hunt is open to all children ages one to 10 years old.

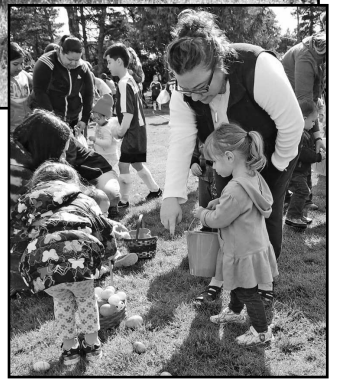
The hunt will consist of more than 4,000 plastic eggs filled with candy, along with some prize eggs sprinkled in.

Community members are encouraged to bring their cameras to commemorate this fun community-supported family

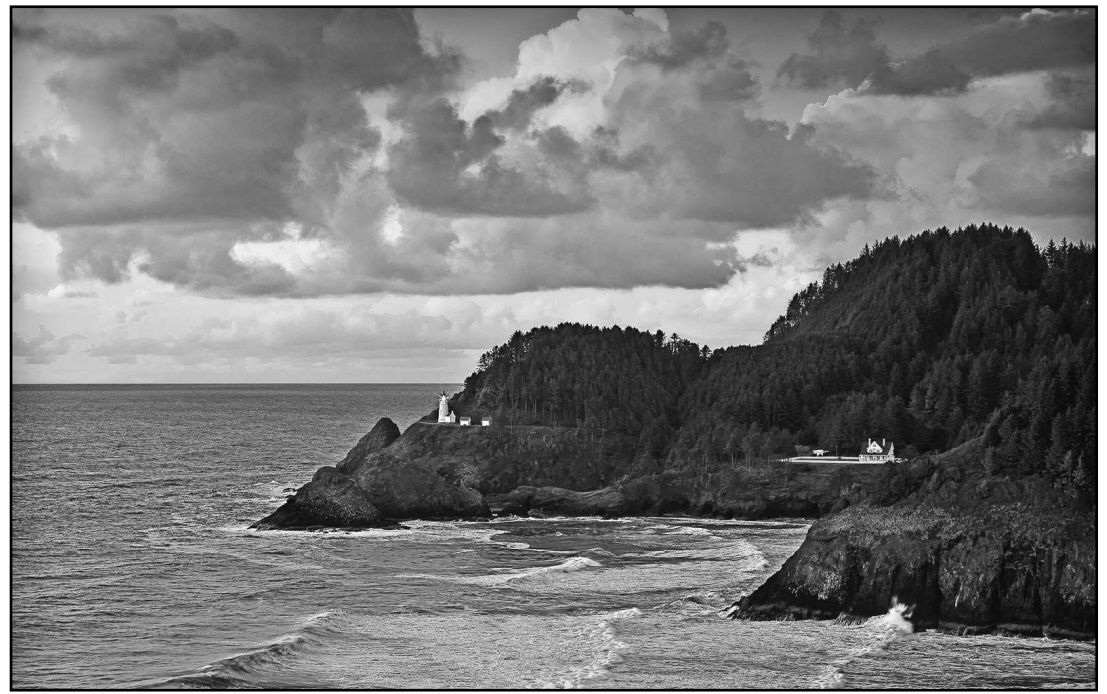
