Rannow’s time in the 3000

meters earned her the second-fastest Class 4A girls time so far this season, with Scappoose senior Linnaea Kavulich holding the top time of 10:18.04.

In the javelin, sophomore

Ryan Rendon-Padilla continued his move up the record book, launching a throw of 167-10 at last Friday’s home meet for a PR, the win and Siuslaw’s fifth-best mark in

school history in the IAAF javelin category.

Also in the spotlight on Friday were sophomore Kiger Johnson, who won the 800-meter race with a season-best

time of 2:07.97, and senior KC Tatum with a PR throw of 139-7.5. Tatum also landed second in the shot put with a throw of 41-7.

Other top finishes for the boys included: sophomore Brendon Jensen, who was third in the 3,000 meters with a PR (9:28.39); senior Isaac Griffes, fourth in the 3000 meters with a PR time of 9:37.37; freshman Ryan Jennings, who was fourth in the 400 meters (58.26) and sixth in the 300-meter hurdles (47.0); junior Robert Mans, who ran a PR time of 2:18.20 in the 800 meters for 10th place; freshman Skylar Loomis, who PRd in the 300 hurdles with a time of 49.87 for 10th place; and third place for the boys 4x400 relay team of Ryan Jennings, Kyle King, Jensen and Johnson (3:47.29).

Top finishes for the girls on Friday included: a second-place throw in the shot put for junior Madison Reynolds with

a season-best mark at 32-2; freshman Andrea Osbon, who PRd in the discus at 101-6 for second place and was fourth in the shot put with a PR of 31-8; junior Davina Galli, who had PRs in the 100 hurdles (19.33), 300 hurdles (55:42) and pole vault (6-0); freshman Brea Blankenship, who was fifth in the 800 meters with a PR time of 2:30.07 and sixth in the 1,500 meters in a PR time of 5:11.74; and sophomore Anne Wartnik with a PR time of 5:16.35 in the 1,500 meters for seventh place.

This weekend, Siuslaw will compete at the Grants Pass Rotary Invitational, with events starting at 10 a.m.

SPRING CHINOOK

Some anglers wait all year for spring Chinook season, and reports of early fish being caught are coming in from the lower Columbia, North Umpqua and lower Rogue rivers. To follow any in-season regulation changes on the Columbia River, check out the regulation update section at the top of the Columbia Zone of the Recreation Report.

ALSEA RIVER: *Steelhead*

Winter steelhead has picked up throughout the river. A mix of wild and hatchery fish are being caught. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.
