Ballots are arriving in the mail at the homes of registered Lane County voters. Before turning in a ballot, voters should remember to review both sides of the ballot.

"Some voters will have voting opportunities on both sides of the ballot," said Lane County Clerk Cheryl Betschart. "Once a ballot has been returned it cannot be amended or recast."

Registered voters anywhere in Oregon who have changed their address still have time to update their registration and qualify for a full ballot.

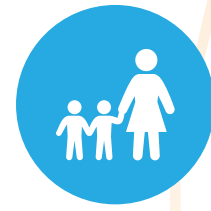

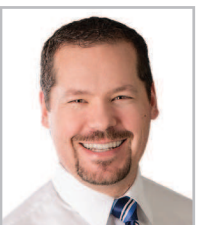
