2018 WATER LINE IMPROVEMENTS

Sealed bids for the construction of the 2018 Water Line Improvements for the Heceta Water People's Utility District (Owner) will be received by Carl Neville, General Manager at 87845 Highway 101, Florence, Oregon 97439 until **2:00 p.m. PDT May 16, 2018** at which time the sealed bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. All interested parties are invited to attend.

The project must be substantially complete 60 days after issuance of Notice to Proceed. Estimated construction cost for the Base Bid is between \$170,000 and \$230,000. The project consists of the following major items of construction:

1. Basic Bid
  - a. Schedule 1 – Location 1
    1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (1.25 Miles from Highway 101).
2. Work includes the following main items:
  - a. Construct approximately 210 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
  - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.
- b. Schedule 2 – Location 2
  1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (2.3 Miles from Highway 101).
2. Work includes the following main items:
  - a. Construct approximately 265 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
  - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.
- c. Schedule 3 – Location 3
  1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (2.6 Miles from Highway 101).
  2. Work includes the following main items:
    - a. Construct approximately 250 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
    - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.
- d. Schedule 4 – Location 4
  1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (3.6 Miles from Highway 101).
  2. Work includes the following main items:
    - a. Construct approximately 275 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
    - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.
- e. Schedule 5 – Option A
  1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (1.9 Miles from Highway 101).
  2. Work includes the following main items:
    - a. Construct approximately 130 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
    - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.
- f. Schedule 6 – Option B
  1. Construct water line improvements on Mercer Lake Road (2.5 Miles from Highway 101).
  2. Work includes the following main items:
    - a. Construct approximately 280 lineal feet of new 8-inch water lines.
    - b. Work includes connections, appurtenances for the water lines, and miscellaneous fittings.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form. No Bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the Instructions to Bidders, and accompanied by a Bid Security executed in favor of the Owner in the amount of not less than 10% of the total amount of the Bid. Per ORS 279.031, Bid Security is to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should the Bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a Contract and provide suitable insurance certificates, bonds, and other required documents for the faithful performance of the work in the event the Bidder is awarded the Contract.

A Pre-Bid conference will not be held.

All Bidders must be "equal opportunity employers" and comply with the appropriate provisions of state and federal law. In addition, all Bidders are required to comply with ORS 656.017 regarding workers' compensation. Bidder, Contractor, and Subcontractors are required to be registered with Construction Contractors Board.

Pursuant to ORS 279.312(2), all Bidders must certify with their Bids that they have an employee drug testing program in place. If awarded a Contract, Bidder must provide proof of such drug testing program when executed Agreements are returned to Owner.

Bidders must prequalify with Owner as specified in the Instructions to Bidders, five (5) days prior to Bid opening.

Each Bidder must submit a first-tier subcontractor disclosure form to the Owner within two working hours of the time for receipt of Bids in accordance with ORS 279C.370. Each Bidder must also submit Evidence of Authority to Sign Bid and Evidence to do Business in the State within two working hours of the time for receipt of the Bid.

The Contractor and every subcontractor on the project shall pay at least the state prevailing rate of wage as determined under ORS 279C.815. ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870 will be administered and enforced in a manner that is consistent with state law and regulations adopted or guidelines issued in accordance with related acts.

No Bid will be received or considered by the Owner unless the Bid contains: 1) a statement that Bidder will comply with the provisions of 40 USC 276a and ORS 279C.840 and 2) a statement as to whether the Bidder is a resident Bidder as defined in ORS 279A.120.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive all informalities, and to accept such Bids that in the opinion of the Owner are in the best interest of the Owner. No Bidder may withdraw or modify this Bid after the hour set for the receipt of Bids, and thereafter until the lapse of 70 days from the Bid opening.
