Port of Siuslaw seeks to fill two board vacancies

The Port of Siuslaw Board of Commissioners will appoint a district citizen to fill the Position 2 vacancy created by the recent resignation of Nancy Rickard and Position 4 vacancy created by the recent resignation of David Huntington following his transition to Port Manager.

The term of the appointee will expire June 30, 2019, at which time an elected successor will be seated.

Persons wishing to be appointed to the Port Commission vacancy should obtain an application from the Port office, 100 Harbor St., or online at www.portofsiuslaw.com.

Applications will be accepted until 5 p.m. Friday, June 15. Applicants must be registered voters residing within the Port of Siuslaw district. Applicants may be invited for interviews.

The Port of Siuslaw is a Special District authorized

by Oregon law to help sustain the economic vitality of western Lane County. The district boundary encompasses most of the Siuslaw River watershed, including the coastal communities of Florence and Dunes City and extending upriver to Mapleton, Walton, Lorane and Blachly.

The Port is the sponsor of the federal maritime investment in Lane County for maintenance of the channel, harbor, jetties and navigable ocean bars. The Port also has significant authority under Oregon statute for local economic development and infrastructure projects that encourage job creation and tourism.

The Port of Siuslaw Board of Commissioners meet regularly at 7 p.m. on the third Wednesday of each month.
