Mapleton sails into state meet Saturday

The Sailors may have had one of the smallest, and certainly youngest, teams at last weekend's nine-team Special District 5 track and field meet at McKenzie High School, it still got big results. The meet capped a season that included 18 personal records, culminating toward four athletes qualifying for state this weekend at Hayward Field in Eugene.

"The most amazing thing is that team consists of only one senior, eight sophomores and six freshmen," said head coach Johnny Sundstrom. "And many of our kids were first-timers."

The team's lone senior, Cole Spencer, qualified for two events after placing second in both the high jump with a mark of 5-8, a height that was

shared with Carver Black of Triangle Lake and Tristan Ware of Glendale. But Black got the title thanks to fewer attempts, with Ware taking third.

In only his second appearance ever in the 300-meter hurdles, Spencer

placed second after clocking a time of 46.96. Parker Wynn of Triangle Lake placed first, also with a PR, in 46.15. In fact, of the nine runners in the event, seven ran personal bests, making Spencer's second-place finish all the more difficult.

Freshman Jeremy Bender was sixth overall with a PR of 53.23. Teammate and fellow freshman Phillip Burnett took seventh in 1:00.28. However, Burnett turned up the heat in the 110 high hurdles, finishing second and

SALMON

May/June means spring Chinook in rivers and basins from Tillamook south to the Siletz. By August attention turns to fall Chinook and coho. There is a rare opportunity to fish for chum salmon (catch-and-release only) on the Kilchis and Miami rivers beginning in mid-September.

STEELHEAD

These ocean-going rainbow trout are divided into two runs: winter and summer. For those that prefer frostbite to sunburn, winter steelhead begin entering area rivers and streams from November and December (depending on the timing of the fall rains) and runs can continue through April.

Summer steelhead returns begin in early April to early June in the Nestucca, Siletz, Trask and Wilson rivers. Summer fish will continue to arrive through late summer and early fall, sometimes overlapping with winter returning fish.

TROUT

Cutthroat trout live in these coastal rivers and streams. Although resident fish may be small, they are feisty and fun to catch. Fishing these cool, shaded waters also can provide a welcome respite from the summer heat. In late summer, look for sea-run cutthroat to migrate from the estuaries back to freshwater to spawn. These can be large, hard-fighting fish.

Dozens of lakes and ponds throughout the zone are stocked with rainbow trout from February through May and, for some, again in October.

WARMWATER FISHING — SOUTH COAST

The south coast area extends along the Oregon
