## DUII enforcement to take place Memorial Weekend

The Florence Police Department will be participating in additional Oregon Impact funded DUII enforcement in May. The high visibility DUII enforcement is scheduled for Friday, May 25 through Monday, May 28 (Memorial Day weekend).

The Florence Police Department reminds people that prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications, and illegal drugs may cause impairment alone or in combination with each other and/or with alcohol. In every State and the District of Columbia, impaired driving is illegal. Whether by drugs — legal or illegal — alcohol, or a combination of both drugs and alcohol, impaired driving puts the driver, their passengers and other road users at risk.

In the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's

National Roadside Survey conducted in 2013-14, 20 percent of drivers that were surveyed tested positive for potentially impairing drugs.

The Florence Police Department has specially trained officers that will be on the lookout for drug and/or alcohol impaired drivers in addition to normal patrols during the month of May.

During the month of April, the Florence Police Department participated in additional DUII patrols with grant funding provided by Oregon Impact.

The Florence Police Department did not make any DUII arrests during the additional grant funded shifts but did make 10 DUII arrests throughout the month of April.
